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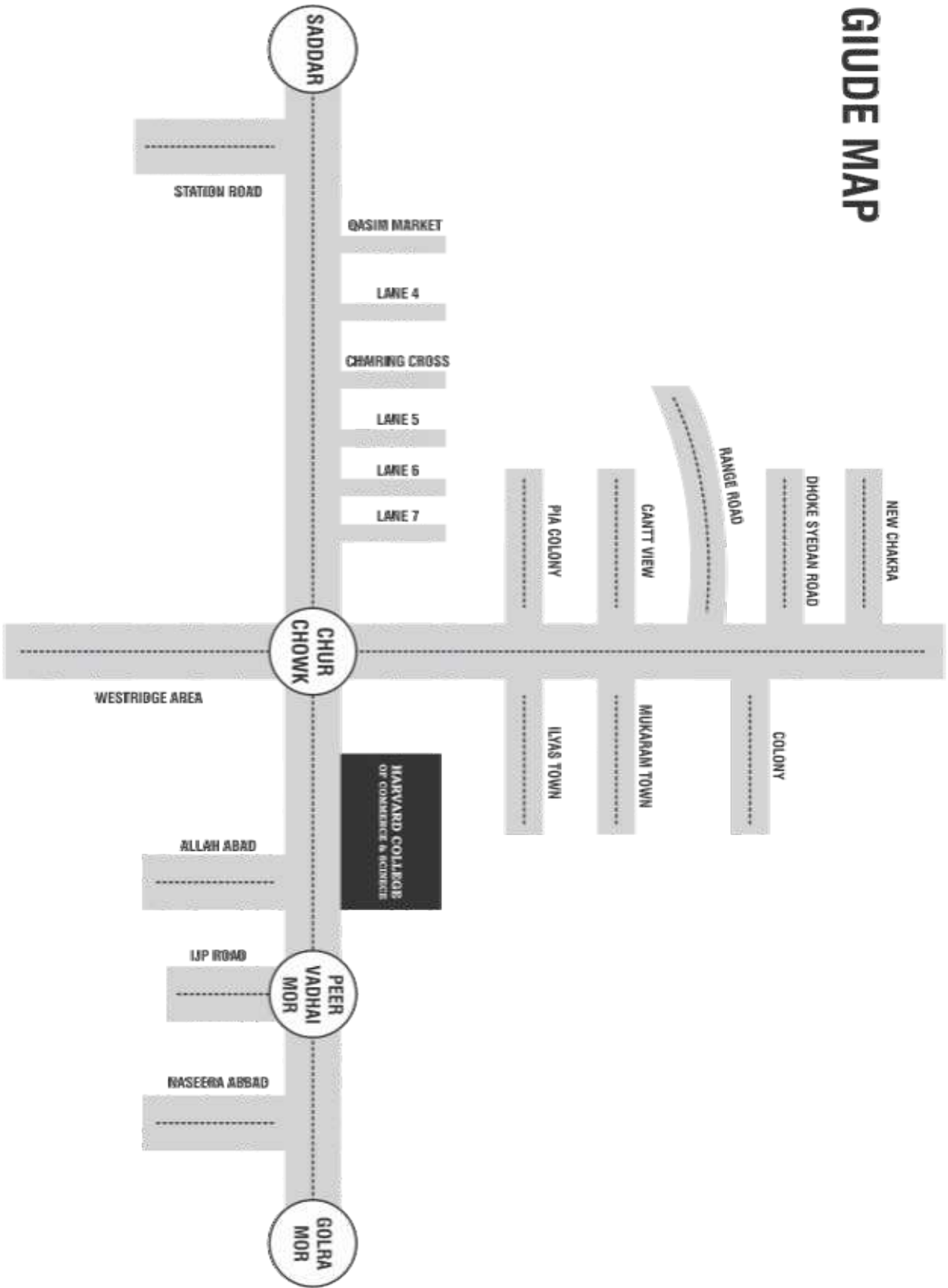

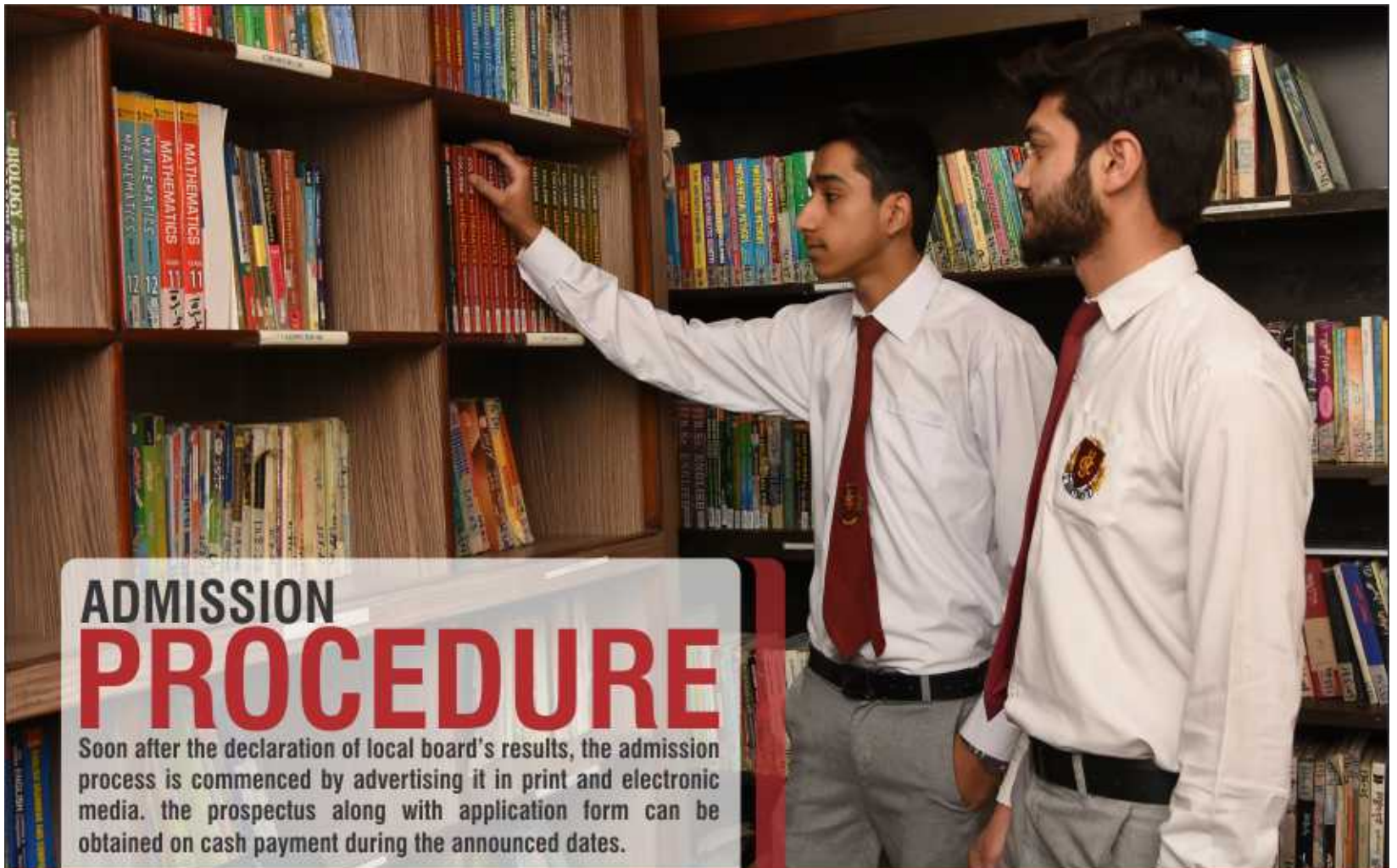

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Soon after the declaration of local board's results, the admission process is commenced by advertising it in print and electronic media. The prospectus along with application form can be obtained on cash payment during the announced dates.

ELIGIBILITY

Admissions are opened to HSSC for all those candidates who have passed the SSC exams from any board. Those who passed O-Level are also eligible for HSSC exams only after taking equivalency certificate.

Minimum marks required for an application to be considered for HSSC is as follow.

ELIGIBILITY FOR JUNIOR SECTION (VI - VIII)

Parents interested in admitting their wards to this prestigious institution must observe these admission rules:

- Admissions are given only on merit. Please do not try getting recommendations.
- A written test will be conducted for students coming from other schools.
- Students need to fulfill age criteria as stipulated by the school.
- Admission test will be conducted for the following subjects:
 - English
 - Urdu
 - Math
 - Science
 - Computer

Failure to get 50% marks in any of the subjects viz. English, Urdu and Mathematics will not be entertained.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SENIOR SECTION (IX, X)

- Students must have studied Pre Ninth and have a sound knowledge of respective subjects.
- Failure to get 60% marks in the admission test will not be entertained.

PLEASE NOTE:

- It is compulsory to get 75% marks during send-up Examination in class (IX - X).

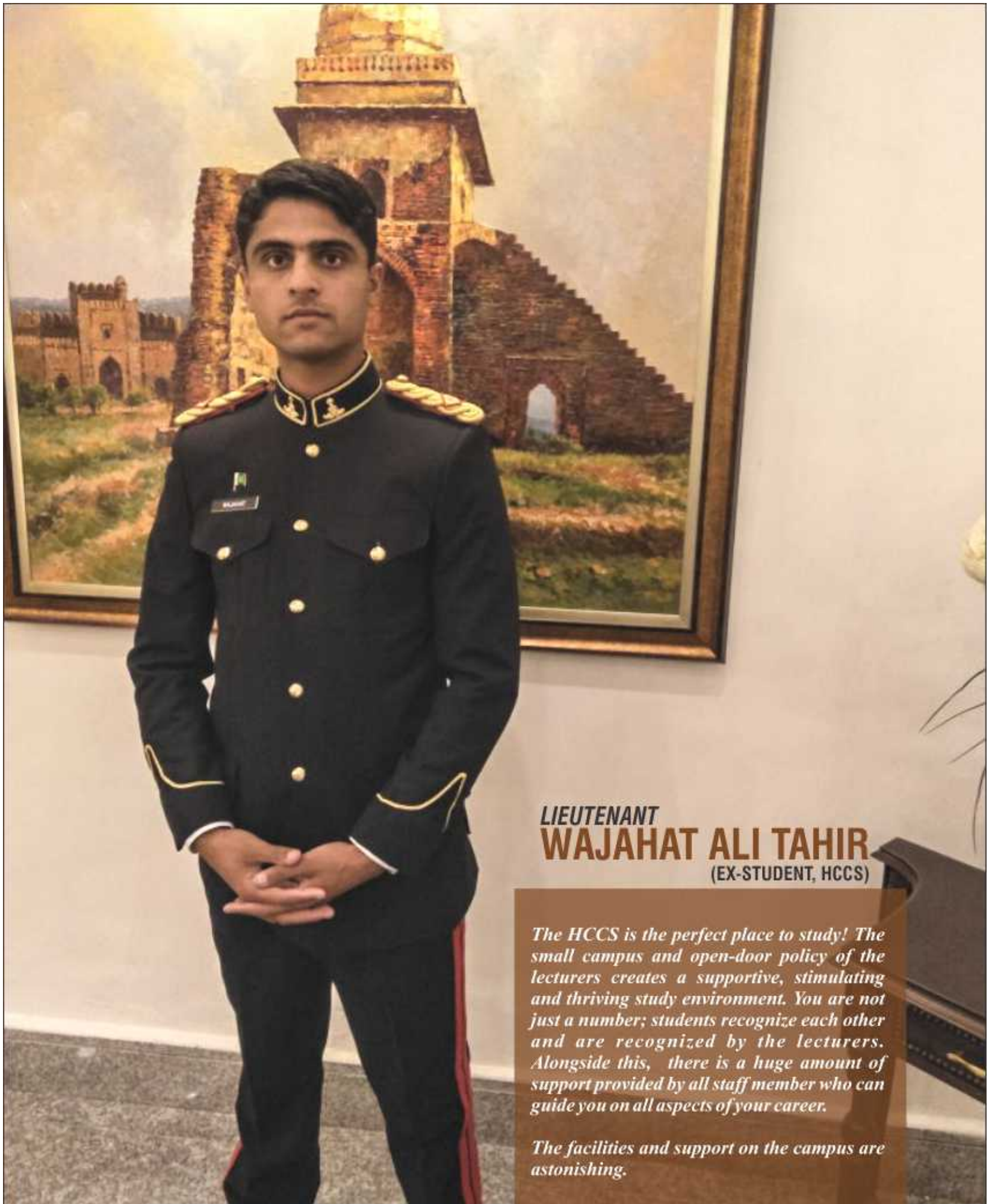

Routine Examination:

Some Facts About NISHAN-E-HAIDER

It is named after the name of Hazrat Ali (R.A), fourth caliph of Islam. Gun metal used for its manufacturing, is captured from the enemy in the previous wars. It is only awarded to personnel of Armed Forces of Pakistan, without any discrimination of rank.

So far total 10 Nishan-e-Haider awards have been awarded, to 7 officers and 3 soldiers. Nine Nishan-e-Haider recipients have been from Pakistan Army and one from Pakistan Air Force. All the 10 recipients got this award for fighting against India. One Nishan-e-Haider was awarded for the 1948 war, one for 1958, one for 1965, five for 1971 and two for 1999 Kargil War. One soldier is also awarded Hilal-e-Kashmir which is equivalent to Nishan-e-Haider.

Nishan-e-Haider is can only be awarded posthumously (awarded only to those armed forces personnel who have lost their lives, fighting with the enemy or performing their duty). Hilal-e-Kashmir (posthumous) is declared as equivalent to Nishan-e-Haider by Government of Pakistan. Here is a brief account of these men, who would be remembered for their feats of courage, bravery and selflessness.

CODE OF CONDUCT

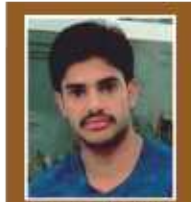

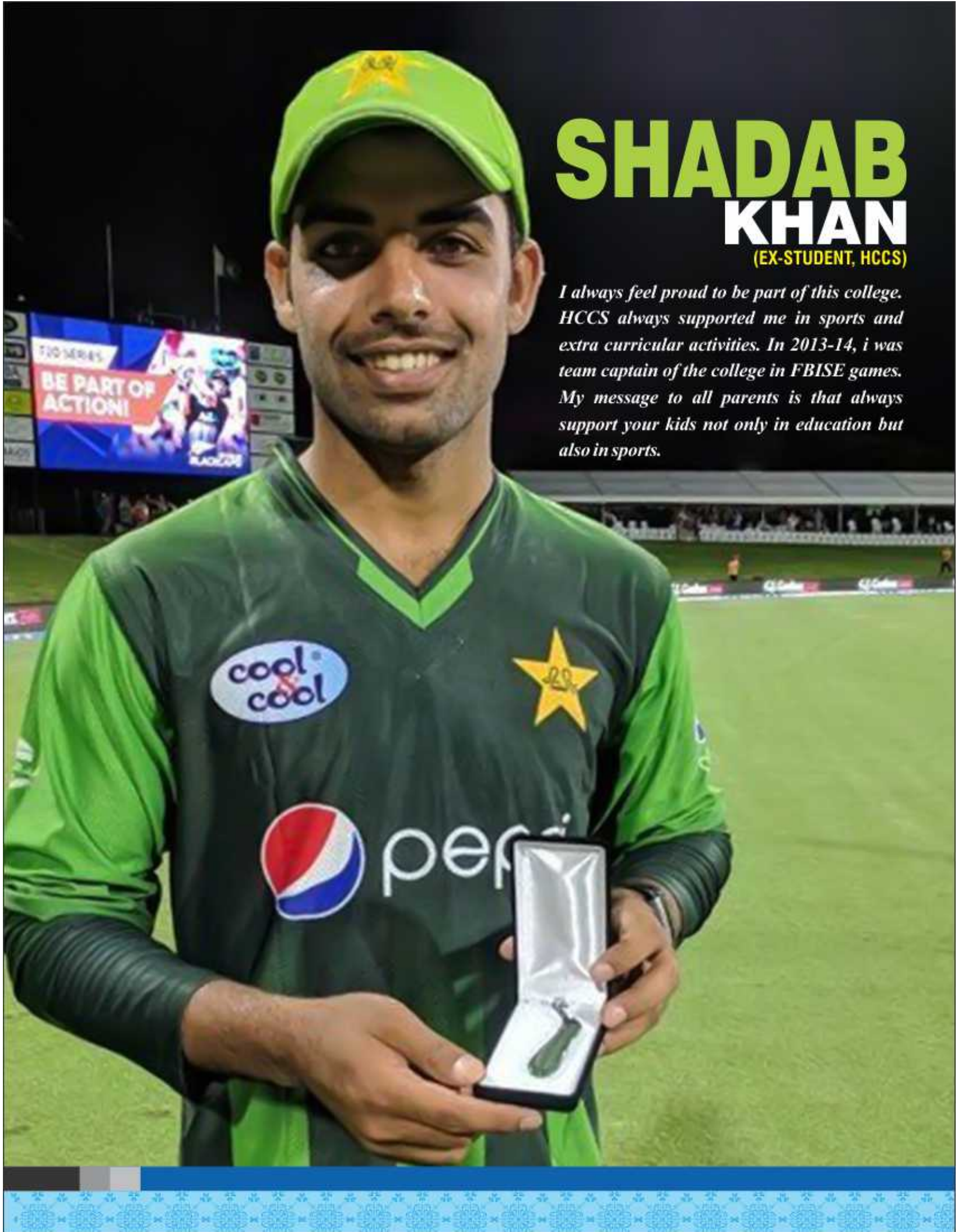

will I pay my full fee in one go, or there is any other easy way?

No. it is not necessary to pay full fee in one go, you can pay it in three or four installments.

How can I pay reduced amount of fee at HCCS?

Has college any committees?

Yes, college has internal control department under which two committees are working.

Recruitment & remuneration committee which is responsible for the recruitment of the college staff.

Disciplinary committee which is responsible for the implementation of rules & regulations and discipline on both students and staff members.

How do you ensure your students are on the right course and career Pathway?

You'll receive information, advice and guidance throughout the session to ensure your future success.

What is the surety of course completion in a given time?

As already mentioned that college has experienced and dedicated staff members. College has rigorous system about courses. College has appointed course coordinators who are responsible for the completion of courses. For this purpose a detailed plan for the coming session has already been prepared. Plan includes DLPs (daily lesson plans), monthly tests, send ups and pre-board examinations. DLPs will available for students once they are admitted in college.

Can I get admission after completion of HSSC-I from any other college or Board?

Yes, you can get admission in 2nd year. However you must provide CLC (college leaving certificate) and migration certificate.

Is a student allowed to get leaving certificate after 1st year?

Yes, every student has right to get CLC (college leaving certificate) only in case of migrating to another city or country. However student must inform us before the completion of HSSC-I exams. Otherwise college leaving certificate will be provided after submission of the 1st installment of HSSC-II and CLC charges.

Do college charge any extra fee for exams or for any other reason?

No. College do not charge any extra fee for routine exams in its first year. Routine exams includes,

- CLASS TESTS
- MONTHLY TESTS
- CHECK POINTS
- SENDUPS EXAMS
- PRE-BOARD EXAMS
- TEST SERIES

However if students fails to clear his/her Sendup exams. Re-sendup fee of Rs. 500 per paper will be charged because Re-sendup exams is not part of routine exams. Any additional activity for betterment of students will be charged accordingly. It should be cleared that annual fund of Rs.4000 will be payable in next year.
